UNIFORM AGREEMENT - 2023

There are four uniforms that can be worn by secondary students for the appropriate occasion:

- (i) Formal Uniform (Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday)
- (ii) Sports House Uniform (Fridays + inter-house activities & carnivals)
- (iii) HPE/PE Subject Uniform (practical HPE & PE classes).
- (iv) Senior Jersey (Monday, Tuesday & Wednesday)

All uniforms are to be neat and presentable: clean, no stains, in good repair, ironed.

(i) Formal Uniform



This uniform is worn on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursdays only.

- College formal hat (bucket hats not allowed);
- Hair ribbons/ties black, green, white only;
- College blouse/shirt;
- College shorts/skirt/culottes (to be of knee length);
 NOTE: Culottes are not to be worn on photograph day all-white above-the-ankle length socks;
- plain fully enclosed all-black lace-up dress leather shoes.



The leather shoes need to be laced and kept black through regular polishing. The black leather design of these shoes is not to go above the ankle. The all-white socks are to be long enough to be well above the ankle bone. Ankle ties/chains should not be visible.

Winter Jumper & Winter Jackets



Official Formal uniform plus

- Bottle-green pullover, jumper or jacket
- Offical 'excursion' jacket e.g. Canberra jacket

Other jumpers or pullovers, can be worn providing:

- ✓ they must be in one colour bottle-green (e.g. no
- ✓ coloured zips, no coloured buttons);
- ✓ No writing/ marking on them

Please Note:

- Bottle-green track-suit pants are only suitable for cross country and athletics carnival days.
- (ii) Girls can wear natural-coloured opaque footed tights of at least 25 denier with their white socks on cold days.
