Tuition Fee Inclusions/Exclusions:

Tuition fees include all costs incurred in the provision of student tuition, subject resources, general cocurricular sport, student accident insurance and include one Yearbook per family. Primary fees include all stationery and resources and swimming lessons (where applicable). Secondary fees include textbook hire, locker hire, student diaries and BYOD IT support for Years 9-12.

Uniforms are available for purchase from the School Locker. The Secondary Student Stationery list will be emailed to parents/carers in the new year. Camps and excursions are partially subsidised. The residual portion of these will be communicated as and when required. Charges apply for lost or damaged textbooks and/or library books.

Music Tuition

Music tuition is offered during school hours, as well as before/after hours (for Secondary students), by our skilled tutors including all stringed instruments (violin, viola, cello) and woodwind instruments (clarinet, saxophone), piano, guitar (acoustic, electric, bass and ukulele), drums and voice. There are also opportunities for involvement in various ensembles, groups and worship bands. Participation in the program is contingent upon maintaining current tuition fee payments.

EDUCATION PROGRAM

Kindergarten program operates during school terms. Please see Kindergarten calendar for operating dates for each group.

Group 1 – attends Monday, Tuesday and alternating Wednesday (8.30am to 3pm) Group 2 – attends Thursday, Friday and alternating Wednesday (8.30am to 3pm)

Inclusions:

Kindergarten fees include the costs of the learning program delivered on site (eg. Stationery, early literacy and numeracy development, art and craft, music, movement and dancing, construction play, physical play and outdoor games, computer activities, puzzles and manipulative toys), and one copy of the ACC Yearbook per family. Parents/carers are responsible for the provision of all food and personal care items.

Enrolment conditions:

Placement in the Early Childhood Centre is dependent upon an interview with the College Principal; shared respect for the school's philosophy and ethos; payment of a non-refundable deposit; and a commitment to participate fully in the 5 days per fortnight program. One full term's notice from parents/carers is required for termination of enrolment.

^{* 5-}day Kindy enrolment utilises two eligible Kindergarten positions. Due to Kindergarten funding guidelines, we are unable to offer any 5-day positions until the beginning of February once the Kindergarten year has commenced to allow access to all eligible enrolments.



Terms and Conditions

Parents/Carers are reminded that they are contractually bound to pay all fees and levies by the due date. Annual fees and levies are charged at the beginning of each year.

All payments are to be made via the FACTS TM payment portal. Families can choose to pay upfront or via an automated direct debit payment plan on a weekly, fortnightly, monthly, or termly payment frequency to suit their circumstances. An invitation to commence a new payment plan or rollover your existing payment plan will be sent early in December 2025.

Automated payments start from the week commencing 12th January and are to be finalized by 20th November.

If a direct debit arrangement is not in place, fees must be paid in full for the entire term at its commencement.

Textbook hire, readers and library borrowing are included in school fees. Lost or damaged library books and textbooks will be billed to the family.

Failure to settle accounts on time may result in additional charges and/or debt recovery action. Parents/Carers experiencing difficulty paying their account should contact the Finance Officer via finance@acc.qld.edu.au as soon as possible.

Notice of Withdrawal of a student is required in writing, one full term in advance. Contact enrolment@acc.qld.edu.au to provide said notice. Failure to provide adequate notice may result in a charge of one term's tuition fees. In situations where a withdrawal is *possible*, but can't yet be confirmed, we encourage you to provide notice of the possible withdrawal. This will be counted towards the notice period should the withdrawal of enrolment proceed.
