

They shared how much they value knowing everyone in their year group personally, and how those connections have grown into strong bonds. They spoke proudly about the way they advocate for one another, offer support, and foster a genuine sense of community. Our Year 12 students take great pride in their camaraderie and the care they show for each other.

They shared that carnivals, camps, and other fun activities have helped them grow in "allowing people to be who they are". In our conversations, they expressed how grateful they are to have learned not to judge, but instead to choose kindness and care for one another. Our Year 12 students also reflected that they feel more confident in engaging in diverse and meaningful conversations.

One student shared that she is not a Christian and she has gained "a lot of respect for how Christians handle stuff and focus on protecting their physical and psychological environment."

They shared how, from what friends at other schools tell them, they feel we have higher behaviour expectations which filters into the culture.

They appreciate being listened to and having opportunities to



share their perspectives on how we can continue to grow as a College. One student highlighted how much they have valued the leadership opportunities available, describing true leadership as relational—walking alongside others to support and encourage them.
