All students are to wear their House sports uniform on the day. Please bring hat, water bottle, sunscreen, runners and running skins/ bike pants/shorts.

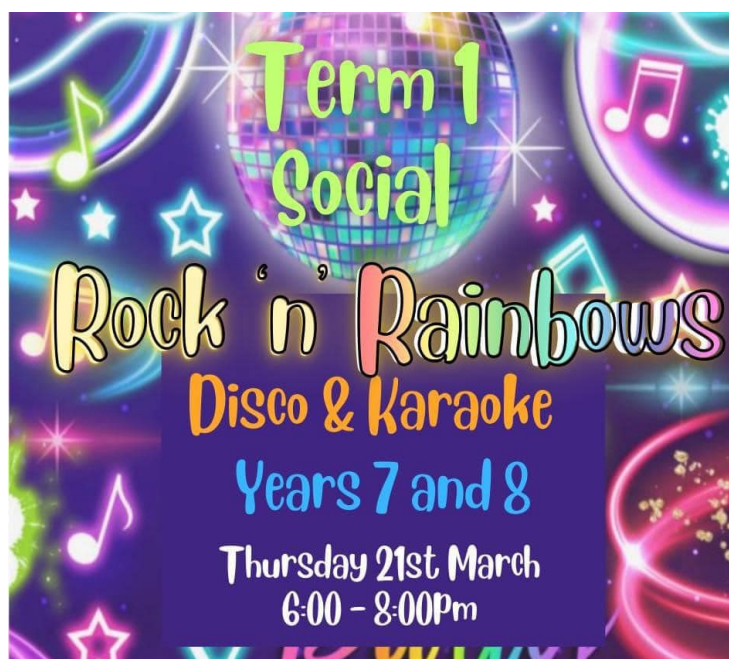

## PUPIL FREE DAY FRIDAY 26TH APRIL 2024

Townsville Catholic Education Office has approved an additional professional development day in 2024.

The date will be Friday 26th April, 2024 and will be a pupil free day. This day follows on from the ANZAC day public holiday on Thursday 25th April. The reason for granting this additional professional development day is to provide the time and opportunity for all teachers to prepare for the implementation of V9.0 of the Australian Curriculum at the commencement of 2025. This planning day will focus on supporting teachers to have a deep understanding of the changes to content and assessment from the current Australian Curriculum to the newly revised curriculum.

There is much planning already occurring in all schools to ensure all teachers are well placed to provide rich learning experiences for their students. This additional professional development day (pupil free day) will only occur in 2024.
