DATE: Monday 27th March 2023

All students (Grades 7-12) must attend the Airport reserve by 8:25am for homeroom roll marking to occur at 8:30am.

Students should be in full and correct sports uniform with House shirt, including College hat.

All students are expected to run in the Cross Country. If they are not able to run, they must provide a written note from their parents/guardian. If students make the Interschool Cross Country team, they will be expected to run in PLAIN BLUE or BLACK skins, PLAIN BLUE or BLACK bike pants, or CCC shorts. Boys will be expected to run in PLAIN BLUE or BLACK skins or CCC shorts. It is recommended that this is organised now so that if your child makes the team, they have the correct uniform. From 10:35 am onwards, students will be transported back to the Mt Carmel Campus. All students are to gather under the Edmund Undercover Area and wait for the morning tea bell. All students will run the distance required for their age group.

DAWN SERVICE AND ASSEMBLY POINTS:


5.40am Assemble at War Cemetery (Front Gates). Dawn Service starts at 5.50am.
