Religious Education

Students will investigate that there are two parts to the Bible; the New Testament and the Old Testament. They will explore certain stories and make connections between Jesus' teachings and how we should live our life today.

The Arts

The unit provides opportunities for students to explore the arts of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples, storytelling through art and how art is used for different purposes.

Technology

In this unit students identify common digital systems, and learn the difference between hardware and software. Students continue to learn how to use these systems safely.

Students will be introduced to the structure and purpose of personal recounts. They will produce a written recount of a Traditional Aboriginal Story. Students will work on simple and compound sentences, and continue to investigate spelling patterns. The class will continue to work on reading and comprehension strategies.

Mathematics

Students will explore a variety of mathematical concepts, including counting patterns, addition, subtraction, informal measurement, telling time, sharing and place value. Students will also find ways to collect and represent data.
