## Exam Block Conditions:

As per [QCAA Directions for Students – External Assessment](#)

Read the directions carefully.

**IMPORTANT: if you breach any of the following directions your result may be withheld.**

1. Do not attempt to gain access to or receive information about any mock or applied subject assessment.
2. Do not allow someone else to sit a mock or applied subject assessment on your behalf.
3. Arrive at least 30 minutes before for your assessment. Contact Ms Byrnes, Deputy Principal - Academic immediately if you will arrive late for your assessment.
4. Bring your own [approved equipment](#). You may use a clear plastic container or ziplock bag to carry it in.
5. Place all prohibited materials in your bag or locker before entering the assessment room. Bags must be stored outside the room.
6. Do not bring food into the assessment room unless you have AARA<sup>1</sup> approval.
7. Follow all directions given by supervisors.
8. Line up in an orderly manner outside the assessment room and follow directions regarding behaviour and equipment checks.
9. Do not enter the room until instructed.
10. Once you enter the room do not speak to anyone except a supervisor — raise your hand and wait quietly.
11. If you have a water bottle, place it on the floor when not in use.
12. Remove your watch and place it in clear view on your desk (**Note:** smart watches and fitness trackers are prohibited). Equipment may be removed from a container or ziplock bag and placed on your desk.
13. Do not pick up any writing equipment or touch a calculator during perusal time.
14. Do not write in the response book or touch a calculator during planning time.
15. Do not cheat or help others to cheat. All work submitted must be your own. Do not look at or copy another student's work.
16. Do not ask to borrow equipment from other students. Do not communicate in any way with any other student.
17. Do not ask anyone to explain or interpret an assessment item.
18. If you need additional assessment materials, or need to leave the room, signal a supervisor by raising your hand and waiting quietly.
19. You will not be able to leave the assessment room in the first 40 minutes of the Scheduled start time except in an emergency (i.e. you may leave after 9:40 am for a morning session and after 1.10 pm for an afternoon session).
20. You will not be able to leave in the last 10 minutes of the assessment session except in an emergency.
21. Carefully follow the instructions written on all your assessment materials.
22. Do not write or draw any offensive content on your assessment materials.
23. Keep your response books intact. Do not remove any pages or parts of pages.
24. Stop writing immediately when instructed to do so by a supervisor.
25. Remain seated and silent while your assessment materials are collected and checked.
