TUITION FEES ARE INCLUSIVE OF LEVIES WHICH COVERS: Academic aptitude testing; some pastoral care presentations; wireless internet access and IT technical support for school related laptop issues; textbooks and digital texts (the QLD State Government grants a textbook allowance directly to the College for QLD residents); student ID card, leadership badges (where applicable); student diary; College magazine; locker hire; during and after school tutoring; Career Pathway Testing; competition and sports nomination fees for curriculum related sport; subject selection handbooks; QCS handbook and testing; curriculum bus transport; printing; photo copying, P&F levy, Capital Levy and School Student Accident insurance.

EXTRAS (Items not included): the following items are not included in the Levies and are referred to as extras: Costs associated with subject excursions; sport outside school hours; replacement ID card, replacement student diary; photos (school, sport, boarding house or Year 12); school based work experience costs and transport; TAFE course costs; Year 12 jersey; Formal costs, tickets to College musical; drama or media productions; hire of musical instruments; College uniform; stationery; class workbooks and book list; co-curricular activities or trips (including overseas).

BOARDING IS IN ADDITION TO TUITION AND INCLUDES: Food (GST applies); cleaning and catering; equipment and resources; Health Centre; laundry service and facilities; residential and supervisory staff; use of gym; some weekend activities; bus transport and some pharmaceutical supplies.

EXTRA BOARDING (Items not included): The following extra boarding items are the responsibility of the parent/carer: elective "out of school" activities; taxi costs (for private individual travel); home travel, bus depot and airport transfers (booked through the College); school based work experience costs and transport; TAFE course costs and transport; toiletries and incidentals; doctor and dentist appointments and pharmaceutical needs.

HARDSHIP CONCESSIONS: The College may provide a limited number of fee concessions each year. Concessions will be considered by the Principal where a demonstrated need exists due to financial circumstances. An appointment with the Principal to discuss financial circumstances may be arranged by contacting the Principal's Personal Assistant. An Application for Concession Form must then be completed and supporting documents provided. All applications will be treated with the strictest of confidence and only the Principal has the discretion to grant financial hardship concessions.
