UNIFORM EXPECTATIONS

The College Academic Uniform must be worn Monday to Thursday with the exception of students participating in practical Physical Education or Fitness classes. It is mandatory for all students to wear their academic uniform on Wednesday for College Assemblies. On Friday, students are required to wear their sport uniform.

The College backpack is a mandatory uniform item and alternative backpacks will not be permitted. The appropriate College hat must be worn to and from school, walking to and from class, during break times and when directed by College staff to do so. It is an expectation that only the Panama hat be worn with the academic uniform and sport hat with the sport uniform. The College sport jacket is exclusively for use with the sport uniform whereas the College pullover can be worn with both uniforms. Other sun-safe procedures should be observed at all times.

ACADEMIC UNIFORM

- College backpack
- College panama hat
- Navy blue knee length College skirt/culottes
- Navy blue College academic shorts/long pants
- Blue and white striped College blouse
- Black closed-in leather school shoes
- Plain white crew socks (no ankle socks)
- College pullover
- College tie
- White or navy hair accessories only
- Black tights
- College blazer (optional)

SPORT UNIFORM

- College backpack
- College sport/house hat
- Navy blue College short or skort
- Navy blue College trackpants
- College sport/house shirt
- Sport shoes (no canvas shoes or high-top shoes)
- Plain white crew socks (no ankle socks)
- One-piece swimsuit
- College sport jacket (optional)

HAIR AND JEWELLERY

- Hair must be of a natural colour tone and style and is not to be bleached (the College reserves the right to decide whether styles and/or colours are unacceptable)
- Hair that is shoulder length or longer must be tied back
- Hair ribbons and other accessories must be navy or white
- Small religious cross/medallion on a fine chain may be worn (not visible when worn)
- No rings can be worn
- Sunglasses may be worn to and from school and at break times
- One pair of small stud earrings or plain sleepers in gold, silver, birthstone or pearl may be worn as a standard lobe piercing only.
- Facial piercings are not permitted nor are clear piercing retainers.
- Inappropriate jewellery items will be confiscated by staff members and returned to students at the discretion of Heads of House/Heads of Year.

MAKEUP

- No lipstick, obvious makeup (including mascara), fake eyelashes or coloured nail polish is to be worn
- No tattoos or artificial nails



UNIFORM EXPECTATIONS

DRESS CODE FOR EXCURSIONS, CAMP/RETREATS OR FREE DRESS DAYS

- Dress standards must be sun smart and non-offensive
- Normal College rules apply to the wearing of hair, jewellery and makeup
- Footwear closed in footwear must be worn (unless otherwise instructed)
- Tops/Blouses/Shirts must be of a suitable length to have no midriff showing and must have sleeves (slogans, logos etc. must be in fitting with the image of St Patrick's College Townsville)
- Shorts must be 'longer shorts' i.e. no shorter than 5cm above the knee. No slashed or frayed jeans or shorts
- Skirts/Dresses must be of an appropriate length to maximise sitting comfortably
