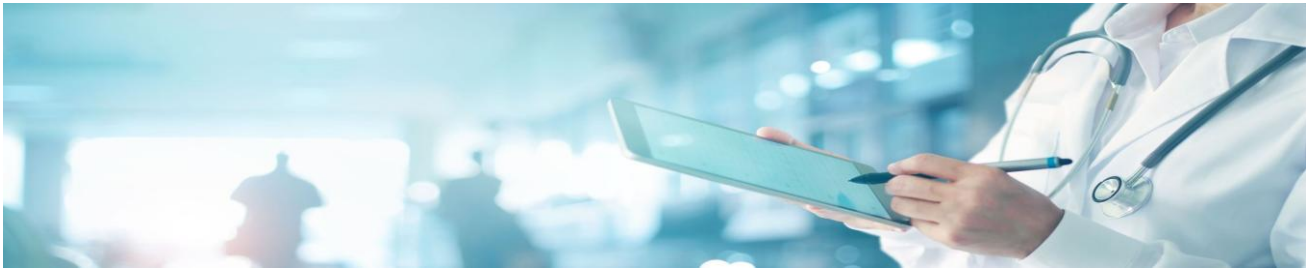

AIG aims to complete initial assessments within 5-10 business days following receipt of completed claim form and all the required information.

NOTE ON MEDICAL EXPENSES: Please be aware that any portion of an expense covered by Medicare, including the Medicare gap, is not eligible for reimbursement under this insurance. The Health Insurance Act 1973 (Cth) strictly prohibits any general insurer from covering any item that is listed on the Medicare Benefits Schedule. This also means that regardless of your out-of-pocket expenses, it is against the law for the Insurer to cover you for the Medicare Gap. Please also note that the insured entity of this policy will not be able to provide reimbursement for the gap in Medical General Practitioner or similar fees.

WHAT DOES THE MEDICAL EXPENSES NOTE MEAN? It means that if you have medical treatment by a registered medical practitioner, medical procedures or hospital costs and there is a portion of those costs covered by Medicare for the treatment, the insurer cannot pay the gap due to the Health Insurance Act.
